

## DOGWOOD ROAD, PORT ALBERNI

M'akola recently completed an envelope and exterior renewal project for Dogwood Road. The project included indigenous artwork that recently had the installation finalized.

Indigenous artwork designs were rendered into 6 foot waterjet cut metal at each entrance to the property welcoming all tenants and guests. The two art pieces honour Tseshaht and Hupacasath nations.

Tseshaht artist Kelly Poirier created a salmon design and Hupacasath artist Klehwetua Rodney Sayers created a hummingbird and dogwood flower design. He states "The hummingbird is the messenger of Joy, and also represents the fragility/delicacy of nature."

The artwork is stunning and when sunlight casts through the design it creates dynamic shadows on the ground for those who pass by.
